In Year Applications

An application can be made for a place for a child at any time outside the admission round and the child will be admitted where there are available places. BCP LA co-ordinates applications (including in-year applications) on behalf of the governors. An application should be made by completing the in-year admissions application form available on the BCP website www.bcpcouncil.gov.uk/schooladmissions. A Supplementary Information Form (SIF) can BCP be downloaded from both the website or the school website www.stjosephs.dorset.sch.uk and must be returned directly to the school so that the governors can place the applicant in the correct category according to their admissions policy. Please see our admissions policy for any supporting documentation required.

Where there are places available but more applications than places, the published oversubscription criteria, as set out in the current admission arrangements will be applied. The admission policy is available on both the school website www.stjosephs.dorset.sch.uk and on the Local Authority website www.bcpcouncil.gov.uk/schooladmissions. Parents are advised to read the admission arrangements carefully before making their application.

If there are no places available, the child can be added to the waiting list. Please see the admission arrangements for more details.

You will be advised of the outcome of your application in writing as soon as possible **but not** later than 15 school days from receipt.

You have the right to appeal to an independent appeal panel if your application is unsuccessful.
