#### **SCHOOL BUILDING FUND**

As a Catholic primary school we belong to the wider Portsmouth Diocesan family of schools and parishes. Being a Christian community we have a duty to support each other and to share our resources where we can.

In order to help with the rising costs of maintaining and improving all the school buildings throughout the diocese, a scheme was started and all schools and parishes were asked to contribute to a central buildings fund.

Schools and parishes are required to send an amount to the Diocesan Schools Building Fund each term based on the number of pupils in the school regardless of whether they are Catholic or not. When a school carries out any major building work that has been approved by the Diocese then it can make a claim against the fund to help meet its statutory obligation of 10% of the costs. Depending on the amount of work needing to be carried out, some years we may claim more than we contribute, other years less.

### How You Can Help

Parents are asked to <u>make a voluntary contribution of only £2.50 per month per child</u> (or £10 per term/ £30 per annum), or as much as they can manage (especially for large families). It is hoped that everyone will be able to contribute something.

Contributions can be made by Parentmail +Pay, cheque, bank transfer or cash, whichever suits you best. Tax can be reclaimed by the school on all donations from taxpayers. If you pay tax please consider completing the Gift Aid section of the form.
